

## Aged Care Act 2024 Resource Overview



### What this resource is

The Sector Resources Overview is a high-level overview of the information, tools and supports that the Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission will release to support implementation of the new Act. It sits alongside the broader reform resources produced by the Department of Health and Aged Care, giving providers a clear line of sight to what is coming and where to find it.

### Who it is for

The plan is written for a wide audience across the aged care system, including providers, frontline workers, older people, families, advocates and other sector stakeholders. It also highlights resources tailored for First Nations communities and culturally and linguistically diverse older people, workers and providers, recognising the need for targeted guidance and support.

### What it contains

The Sector Resources Overview maps out a suite of products such as guidance materials, webinars, fact sheets, videos and training programs, organised by topic so users can quickly find what they need. It signals when new or updated materials will be released, helping providers plan their own internal change, workforce preparation and governance activities ahead of key reform milestones.

### Why it matters for providers

For providers, this resource is a practical implementation aid, linking the legal requirements of the Aged Care Act 2024 with educational and operational resources. Using this resource as a reference point can support board oversight, executive planning and on-the-ground readiness activities, ensuring the sector is better positioned to deliver safe, rights-based, person-centred care under the new legislative framework.

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
